Strategic Quality Improvement Management in Islamic Educational Institutions

In addition to the lack of creativity among educators in guiding students, the centralized curriculum further clouds the picture of education quality.

Human management enables the recognition of abilities, along with strengths and weaknesses. Management offers more effective and efficient methods of carrying out work, reducing obstacles in achieving goals, and providing predictions and insights to enable humans to anticipate rapid environmental changes. Method

Therefore, this discussion focuses on two key points: the implementation of strategic management in enhancing the quality of education at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram and the strategic management steps to enhance the quality of education at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram.

Unlike the other three functions (planning, organizing, controlling), actuating is considered the essence of management because it specifically relates to people. In actuating, people work according to their tasks to effectively achieve set objectives. In practice, management is expected to have the skill to motivate and lead others. d. Controlling: To ensure that work aligns with the vision, mission, rules, and work programs, controlling

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is necessary. This can take the form of supervision, monitoring, inspection, and auditing. These terms have different meanings but are all aimed at early detection of deviations in the planning, implementation, and organization stages. This allows for immediate corrections, adjustments, and adaptations in response to the situation, conditions, and changing times.

Based on the above description, it can be concluded that management functions are carried out with the goal of maximizing human and other resources that support the effective and efficient achievement of educational quality standards.

2. Management Strategy Steps in Enhancing the Quality of Education at SMA Yayasan Pondok Pesantren Darul Hikmah Mataram

Every school, in its effort to improve the quality of education, has different management strategies tailored to its specific needs, vision, and mission. In the endeavor to enhance the quality of education at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram, there are several indicators that support these efforts, as outlined below: a. Discussion

Based on the research results obtained by the researcher and the efforts made by the school regarding strategic management to improve the quality of education at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram, two main aspects are identified: analyzing the implementation of strategic management and the management strategy steps to enhance quality.

1. Implementation of Strategic Management to Enhance the Quality of Education at SMA Yayasan Pondok Pesantren Darul Hikmah Mataram

When it comes to improving the quality of education in schools, strategic management is a crucial factor. It is a systematic approach for the responsibility of management, conditioning the organization to a position that ensures it achieves surprising results. In connection with the earlier discussion, the indicator for the application of strategic management is analyzed by examining the concept of strategic management itself. 2. Management Strategy Steps to Enhance the Quality of Education at SMA Yayasan Pondok Pesantren Darul Hikmah Mataram

Several sub-results are discussed, focusing on the analysis of management strategy steps to improve the quality of education at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram. Different educational institutions

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have their unique strategic policies. In the case of SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram, they have their own strategic policies, including the following stages:

a. Development for Improving the Quality of Teachers

In the pursuit of enhancing school quality, the responsibility isn't only on students but also on teachers, especially those who teach at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah. They participate in programs to elevate the quality of teachers. Programs include workshops, training, and Musyawarah Guru Mata Pelajaran (MGMP).

b. Promotion of SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram

The promotion of SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram is similar to the promotion of other schools. It highlights the unique features and strengths of the school and its various departments. Special activities like tahfidz (Quran memorization), Quran reading and writing, and Islamic studies are emphasized to attract students.

c. Special Programs

- Arabic Club: This is a program for rapid learning of the Arabic language in a fun and enjoyable way. It takes place weekly on Fridays, allowing students to practice Arabic conversation with their peers or mentors.
- 2) Tahfidz and Tahsin, Quran Reading and Writing, and Kitab Kuning: These programs are designed to enhance students' knowledge of the Quran and Islamic texts. These programs were introduced starting from the 10th grade and cater to different proficiencylevels.

d. Facilities and Infrastructure

Based on the findings, the facilities and infrastructure at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram have significantly improved compared to the early years, especially the first cohort of the school. Currently, the facilities and infrastructure are complete and adequate. Students in the religious program receive good facilities, including spacious classrooms with LCD screens and a wide range of reference materials, ensuring a comfortable learning environment.

Conclusion

Based on the data analysis and previous discussions, the following conclusions can be drawn:

- 1. Strategic management is a long-standing approach to improving the quality of education with the aim of achieving predefined educational goals as established by the relevant laws. The application of strategic management encompasses internal and external analysis, extending to the evaluation of strategic outcomes to determine the extent of success. Furthermore, it relies on various factors, including adequate facilities, support from the community, and government backing.
- 2. Quality improvement in education encompasses both the processes and outcomes of education, and these elements mutually influence each other. Assessing the quality of education involves considering various factors such as optimal learning processes, adequate facilities, professionally skilled teachers with diverse abilities, and support from various stakeholders.
- 3. Based on the discussions, it is evident that there is a significant influence of the application of strategic management on the improvement of educational quality at all levels of education.
- 4. The management strategy steps taken by SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram include efforts to develop a school designed with various elements, such as: a. Enhancing the quality of teachers. b. Promoting the school. c. Implementing special programs like the Arabic Club, Tahfidz and Tahsin, Quran reading and writing, and Islamic studies, along with regular religious activities. d. Improving facilities and infrastructure.

These steps have contributed to an overall improvement in the quality of education at SMA YayasanPondokPesantrenDarul Hikmah Mataram, which supports the goal of enhancing educational quality.

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
